 reporting tools to develop a suite of dashboards and other reporting tools
- Design and customize software systems and platforms to improve customer (staff and patients) experience
- Evaluate vendors and negotiate vendor contracts to ensure that service level agreements are met. Work closely with IT vendors to ensure clear and timely communication of service needs, challenges and solutions
- Direct the financial activities of the IT department, budgets, analysis of costs, value, and risks of information technology in order to advise management and recommend actions
- Work in conjunction with other team members to support data informatics collection and use at all levels including CQMs, UDS and other reporting requirements
- Facilitate the assessment, documentation, and recommendations for business processes and workflows to achieve current and future IT-supported objectives
- Act as Security Officer, performing audits and investigations related to IT policies
