POSITION SUMMARY:

Reporting to the Data Services Manager, the Data Analyst supports the organization's goal of improving patient safety, patient experience, quality of care, health equity, and overall healthcare costs by collecting, cleaning, analyzing, and interpreting clinical, financial, and operational datasets. The data is also used for quality improvement and practice transformation work to ensure maintenance of Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH) recognition.

The Data Analyst creates and maintains daily, weekly, monthly, quarterly, and annual reports using SQL, Tableau and OCHIN Epic tools such as Slicer Dicer, Business Objects and Reporting Workbench. This includes recurring reports for internal and external stakeholders as well as daily ad hoc reports requested by individual staff members or committees.

This position develops and maintains training documents in collaboration with the Data Services Manager and provides training to staff regarding available data and reports.

- Creates and maintains reports and modifies code using various tools such as Tableau, SQL and OCHIN Epic tools such as Slicer Dicer, Business Objects and Reporting Workbench.
- Collects, cleans, analyzes, and interprets data from various sources in support of strategic goals, performance improvement, grants and converts to usable reports or dashboards accessible by all staff.
- Documents methodology to allow for better understanding of dashboard architecture, data schema, formulas and predicative analytic algorithms used in reports.
- Works closely with Operations, Clinical, Finance and HIT Teams to ensure data integrity through data validation methods and quality data collection.
- Collaborates with EHR Support Analyst to identify shared fields or updates with EHR/PM system and supporting applications.
- Trains staff in developing self-service reports and educates staff on available data and reports.

- Related bachelor's degree, or in lieu of a degree, 2+ years of relevant work experience. A
 combination of education, certification, or relevant work experience may be considered.
- One or more years of hands-on experience with statistical and inferential analytics.
- One or more years of experience with analysis tools such as SQL and data visualization software.
- Proficiency in MS Office; Word, Excel, Outlook, PowerPoint, Visio, Teams as demonstrated by previous experience.

- Master's Degree.
- Familiarity with EHR systems, preferably OCHIN Epic.
- Familiarity with UDS, PCMH, MU, MIPS, HEDIS, OSHPD or similar programs.
- Sound knowledge of ETL frameworks, data management systems and data warehousing.
- Experience working in a non-profit healthcare setting desirable, FQHC preferred.
